This Privacy Policy describes how Cathedral Holdings, Inc. ("Cathedral Holdings," "we," "our," or "us") collects, uses, and shares personal information and other data that we may collect from our customers (individually, "you") when you use or visit the webpage www.cathedralholdingsinc.com and any related subdomains and their pages or online services (collectively, our "Website"). Cathedral Holdings engages in business-to-business sales as a chemical distributor that provides raw materials, and creative problem solving and expertise to other businesses.

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your personal information and how we will treat it and other data collected from you. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, your only recourse is to stop using our Website. By accessing or using our Website, you agree to this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy may change over time. 1. Information We Receive or Collect From You

To provide you with our products and services, we collect several types of information from and about you when you visit our Website, including, but not limited to, the following types of information:

- Contact Information: When you contact us via email or through our Website, you may
 provide us, and we may collect, certain contact information, including your name, email
 address, location, and telephone number ("Contact Information"). We may also collect and
 keep records or copies of your correspondence, if you contact us, so that we may better
 serve you.
- Information You Choose to Provide to Us: You have the ability to provide a variety of information during your interactions with us, such as emails you may send us or by filling in forms or surveys on our Website, which may include Contact Information and other information about you or your business.

2. Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies

• Details about your visits to our Website, including traffic data, location data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on our Website.



 Information about your computer or device's Internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type.

The information we collect automatically helps us to improve our Website and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including by enabling us to:

- Store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize our Website according to your individual interests.
- Speed up your searches.
- Recognize you when you return to our Website.

The technologies we use for this automatic data collection may include:

- Cookies (or browser cookies). A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer. You may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser. - Web Beacons. 6. How We Share Information We Receive or Collect From You With Others

- With contractors, service providers, vendors, and other third parties we use to support our business and who perform services or functions on our behalf (collectively, "Service Providers"). - With your consent.
- With a buyer or our successor in interest in the event of a corporate reorganization,
 restructuring, merger, divestiture, dissolution, or sale of all or substantially all of our assets,
 whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or other similar
 proceeding, in which information held by us about our products and users is among the
 assets transferred.
- In order to (i) comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request; (ii) protect or defend the legal rights or property of ours, or the legal rights of our business partners, employees, agents, and contractors (including enforcement of our agreements and terms of service); (iii) protect the safety and security of our users or members of the public including acting in urgent circumstances; or to (iv) protect against fraud or to conduct risk management.

Data Sharing: If your information is transferred or shared as described in this Privacy Policy, we will seek assurance from the recipients of such information (prior to the transfer) that they will



safeguard the information in a manner consistent with this Privacy Policy. We ask recipients of such information to enter into a contractual relationship with us that includes confidentiality and non-disclosure clauses and provides the same level of commitment to and protections of information as provided in this Privacy Policy.

7. Managing Your Information

- Modification of Your Contact Information: You may contact us to access, correct, or modify
 your Contact Information or any other information that you provide to us. We generally
 respond to such requests within five business days of receiving a request, but it may take up
 to 30 days depending on the volume of requests we receive. We may not accommodate a
 request to change information if we believe the change would violate any law or legal
 requirement or cause the information to be incorrect.
- Retention of Your Contact Information and Other Information: We will retain and use information we receive or collect about you as long as needed to provide you with service. We will retain and use this information for the purposes for which it was collected (as specified in this Privacy Policy or as we disclose to customers outside of this Privacy Policy), including to provide products and services to you, comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our agreements. Your information may persist in copies made for backup and business continuity purposes for additional time.
- Promotional, Marketing Communications from Us: If you do not wish to have your name and email address used by us to promote our own or third parties' products or services, you can opt-out by clicking the unsubscribe function located at the bottom of the email. We will continue to send you transaction confirmation emails and other product-related announcements when it is necessary to do so or otherwise where we are permitted to do so by law. For instance, if our Website is temporarily suspended for maintenance, we might send you an email. Generally, you may not opt-out of these communications.
